Brothers,

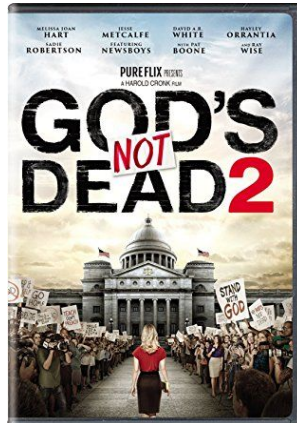

## FATHER COREY'S CHAT

The Church finds herself in a great crisis that none of us could have imagined in our time growing up in the Church. The clerical scandals have created crimes and sins against minors and terrible shame and danger to the Body of Christ. This scandal is far reaching geographically and includes clergy from the status of priests, to Cardinals. The purification necessary and the ramifications will exist for decades.

What will be the response of the laity to this terrible reality we are experiencing? Anger, doubt, loss of faith, fear and disgust. All of this is justified and should not be judged. All these reactions are justified

and should be expected. And yet, we need to minister to all of those with these reaction and love them more and more.

It is our call, as faithful Catholic gentlemen, even having these feelings ourselves, to go deeper into our spiritual selves and in charity and love reach out to those tempted to abandon the Church, to let their disappointment, anger or bitterness kill their relationship with Christ or the Church.

We as Knights are going to be challenged as never before in our lifetimes to respond with heroic faith and charity. This is going to demand that we deepen our own faith through more prayer, fasting and living out of our Order's purposes. I suggest the daily reception of the Eucharist for all of us if possible, the daily recitation of the Holy Rosary, the daily Prayer to Saint Michael the Archangel (see below), and any possible acts of charity towards anyone in need.

Christ will raise up holy men and women among the laity to lead us out of this crisis, he will raise you up to assist Holy Mother Church in this terrible hour! Will we respond as Knights? Will we please, will we? Christ needs us! The Blessed Mother needs us! Those harmed as victims need us, please, as Knights answer YES! Let us begin!
